How the eligible care and support need is being met informally

Ongoing OT intervention to provide a self propelling shower seat which will allow Robert to be able to independently shower. Rob has had difficulty with getting his leg trapped in the seat even though it has been turned around.

How the unmet eligible need will be met by Personal Budget (if relevant)

Due to ongoing issues with the provision of hot water in Robert's cell, he currently requires assistance daily to have a shower.

Daily 30 min call DH to support with:

Collecting shower items and taking shower chair into showers.

Holding chairs whilst transfer to s/chair takes place, there have been a few occasions where he is unsteady and we have had to prevent him falling.

Wash back

Dry back

Support with transfer back to w/chair

Take shower chair back to cell.

On release the recommendation would be for Robert to be in accommodation that has shower facilities that he is able to access. Robert may need additional equipment such as rails in place to support this depending on the release destination. This may change nearer to release if there is any change in need in the meantime.

While in IPD Robert's laundry is collected by the person in charge of laundry and returned to him when cleaned. Robert will need a wing carer to support him with laundry when he is back on the wing.

How the unmet eligible need will be met by Personal Budget (if relevant)

Rob is able to dress and undress himself on his bed in his cell however when he has a shower he needs support with having his clothes passed to him and to be supported with putting on his bottom half clothing so he is dressed appropriately to return to his cell. Carers to provide support AM 30 mins double handed.

Any information and advice to prevent, reduce and delay developing needs

On release the recommendation would be for Robert to be in accommodation that has accessible space for him to do his own laundry. Robert may need initial support to learn how to use the laundry facilities. This may change nearer to release if there is any change in need in the meantime.

How the eligible care and support need is being met informally e.g. by my carer, the community, equipment

Ongoing intervention by Occupational Therapy to identify resolutions to support Robert with transfers due to the environment.

There is a disabled toilet next to Robert's cell which has suitable grab rails in place.

Robert needs support from staff to be able to unlock him as needed to access this toilet. Grab rails cannot be installed in the cell as the walls are not stable enough in the cell. A wheeled commode cannot be placed over the cell toilet as the floor is too uneven and it is not safe to support Robert's transfers.

How the unmet eligible need will be met by Personal Budget (if relevant)

On release the recommendation would be for Robert to have necessary equipment in place to allow him to safely transfer to the toilet eg rails, toilet frame depending on the discharge environment.

How the eligible care and support need is being met informally

As a double amputee, Robert is currently moving around using a wheelchair. He is awaiting an assessment for a new one. A hospital bed is in situ which Robert is able to lower to the appropriate height to enable him to independently transfer on and off of using his own technique. Robert does have episodes of phantom leg following his recent amputation and has attempted to stand believing he had a leg, resulting in falling. He has used his own techniques however has sometimes had to call out for help. Due to the lay out of the cell it is not possible to put grab rails by the toilet in the cell.

How the unmet eligible need will be met by Personal Budget (if relevant)

Any information and advice to prevent, reduce and delay developing needs

On release the recommendation would be for Robert to be in accommodation that can meet his physical health needs and have the necessary equipment in place. Robert would benefit from a lifeline to be able to summons help in the home environment. This may change nearer to release if there is any change in need in the meantime.
